Our first device into market, the male Uro-Gard™, is designed for dryness, extended wear and freedom through mobility. It uses a comfortable base layer, applied to the patient weekly, and a flexible soft sheath. Urine will flow in one direction, through a one-way valve into a separate, detachable collection pouch. The device can be worn under clothing for outings or activity, and supports limited interaction with patients for safe social distancing.
